***Art Detective Game***

- Divide the class into two teams. Randomly select a member from one team to answer a question. Give the students time to answer on their own, then allow them to consult their team if they don't know the answer. Go back and forth between the two teams until they have answered all the questions.

Primary, secondary, intermediate, and complementary are all examples of what?

Answer: color

What name do we call the colors yellow, red, and blue?

Answer: primary colors

These colors are made by mixing two primary colors together.

Answer: secondary colors

These colors are made by mixing a primary color with a secondary color that is next to it on the color wheel.

Answer: intermediate colors

The lightness or darkness of a color refers to the what of a color?

Answer: value

What do you call a color that has been lightened with white?

Answer: a tint

What do you call a color that has been darkened with black?

Answer: a shade

Straight, zigzag, curved, and wavy are all examples of what?

Answer: line

What is two-dimensional and can be categorized as either geometric or freeform?

Answer: shape

What starts someplace and stops someplace and leaves a path as it is drawn across the paper?

Answer: a line

Triangle, circle, hexagon, and square are all examples of what?

Answer: movement

This is a variation of objects within a composition that provides interest or uniqueness.

Answer: variety

This is the look or the feel of any surface.

Answer: texture

The placement of objects in the foreground, middle ground, and background can create the illusion of what in a composition?

What is the part of a composition that lies between the foreground and the background?

This is an element of art that has to do with objects that have three dimensions—height, width, and depth.

Answer: form

This is the principle of art that makes all the separate elements of an artwork look as if they belong together.

Answer: unity

Artists use this design principle to draw the viewer's attention to the important part of their artwork.

Answer: emphasis

This design principle gives the viewer a feeling of visual weight. It can be symmetrical, asymmetrical, or radial.

Answer: balance

What style of art uses unrealistic colors for expressive purpose?

Answer: Fauvism

What style of art uses the elements of art and principles of design as the primary subject matter of the artwork?

Answer: Abstract

This is a style of art in which the subject matter is broken apart, flattened, shown from multiple points of view, and reassembled to the artist's own desire.

Answer: Cubism

Which style of art represents the subject of a picture accurately, and in a way that is true to life?

Answer: Realism

In which style of art is the subject painted with dots of color?

Answer: Pointillism
